Breakfast at the hotel and start Tbilisi City Tour .

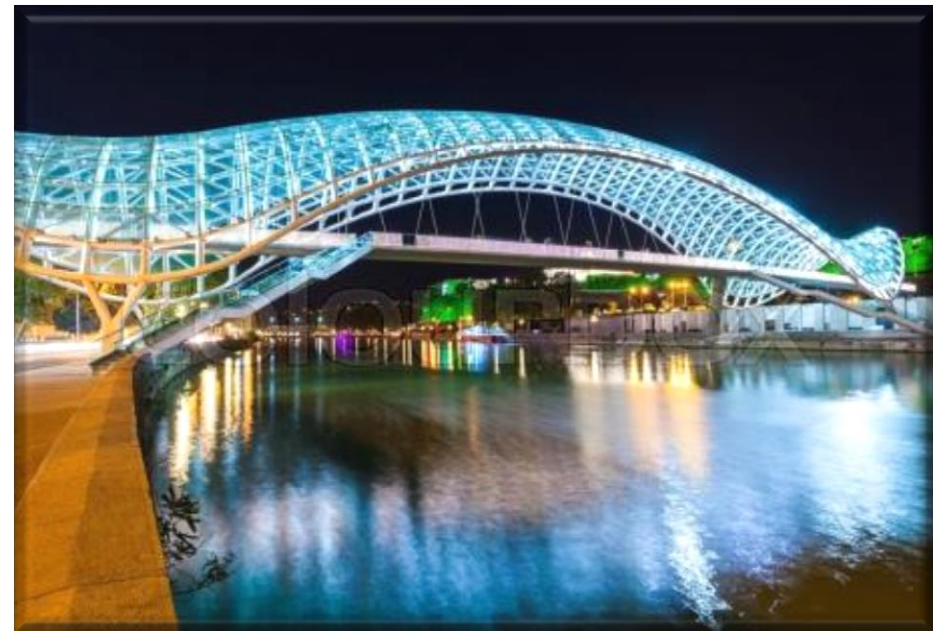
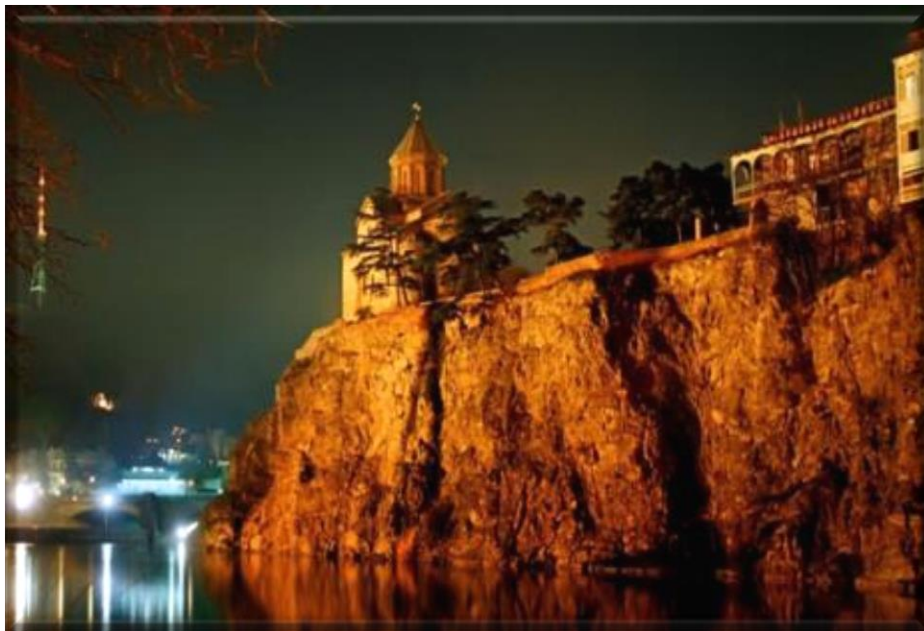
The capital of Georgia – Tbilisi, is the ancient multicultural city.

Here you will be captivated by a thrilling blend of eastern enigma and western elegance. The traditions of the East and West meet hereto form a culture unlike any other in the world. During the tour we take you to the places that will show you old city.

You can take a glance to the history of the city from early centuries to nowadays by walking in narrow streets of the city. And exploring the religious and secular architecture. Here you find different religious buildings –churches, synagogues, mosques, as well as famous 19th century houses with wooden multi-colored balconies.

You will have the opportunity to discover the best of Tbilisi Sightseeing from high above the city streets with the red double-decker bus tour. During the tour you will discover the best of Tbilisi city Sightseeing such as : Meidan square, Sulphur bath district, Mtkvari River ,Rike Park, Peace bridge, Freedom square, Rustaveli avenue, Dry bridge Agmashenebeli Avenue and much more .

## Tbilisi Highlights





Mtskheta day trip offers you to escape the city and visit the oldest city of Georgia within just few hours. During the tour, you can enjoy panoramic aerial views of mountains around Jvari Monastery, observe the confluence of Aragvi and Mtkvari rivers, or have a time trip back to early centuries in the area of Svetitskhoveli cathedral and Samtavro church, at the end of the tour you will taste Georgian wine.

During the tour we will visit:

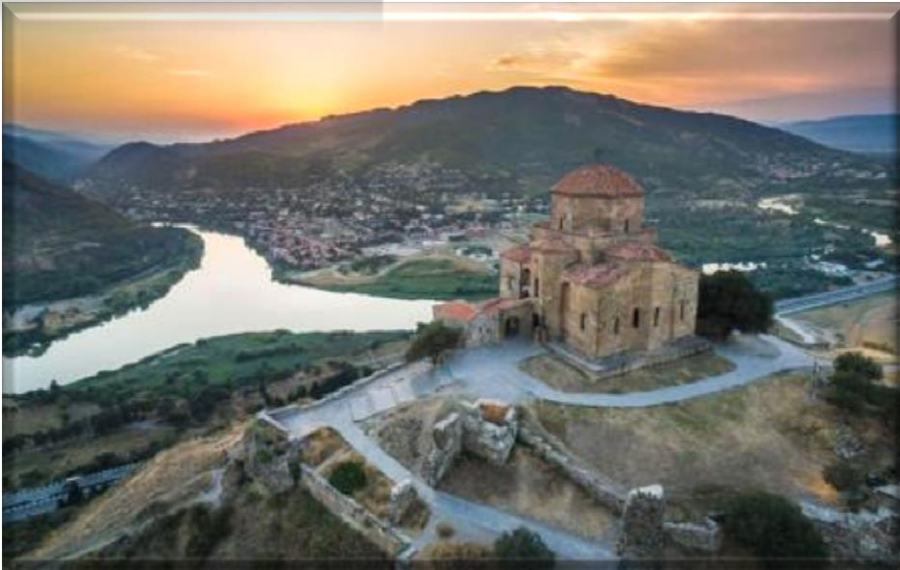
**Mtskheta** is one of oldest cities of Georgia near Tbilisi. Mtskheta was capital of the early Georgian Kingdom of Iberia from the 3<sup>rd</sup> century BC to the 5th century AD. Here Georgians accepted Christianity in 317 and Mtskheta remains the headquarters of the Georgian Orthodox and Apostolic Church.

**Jvari Monastery** is a Georgian Orthodox monastery of the 6th century near Mtskheta (**World Heritage site**). The name is translated as the Monastery of Cross. The great church represents the peak of the architectural typology. It is a true architectural masterpiece of the early Medi period overlooking the confluence of Aragvi and Mtkvari rivers from the top of the hill.

**Svetitskhoveli** Cathedral was built in the 11th century, although the site itself is even older, dating back to the early 4th century. It differs in its artistic value, magnificence, harmony and the special role it has played in the history.. The cathedral is the second largest church building in Georgia and is listed as a **UNESCO World Heritage** Site along with other historical monuments of Mtskheta.

**Wine Degustation** – where you can taste and buy Georgian wine.

## Mtskheta Highlights



### Day 3

Breakfast at the hotel and day tour to Ananuri – Kazbegi mountains.

On our tour to Ananuri-Kazbegi mountains you will have an exciting drive, heading north along the Georgian Military Highway into the high Caucasus Mountains. This is the main road running for 220 km from Tbilisi to Vladikavkaz in Russia, a spectacular highway that winds its way through sheer mountains. This route actually dates back to 1st century BC and is still important as the only link connecting to Russia through Caucasus Mountains.



**The Zhinvali Dam** – a hydroelectric dam on the Aragvi River in Zhinvali, Georgia in the Caucasus Mountains. Despite its obviously artificial origins, reservoir blends in with the surrounding environment perfectly and delights visitors with its Turquoise waters. Enjoy the view of the reservoir from Ananuri Fortress, which is a popular tourist sight and for its stunning, panoramic views.



**Ananuri** is a fortress situated on the foreland by the Aragvi River, not far from Zhinvali water reservoir and about 70 km from Tbilisi, Georgia. It was built by the Dukes of Aragvi and its earliest parts date from the 13th century. The fortress is on the UNESCO Tentative list.

**Monument or Treaty of Georgievsk Monument** is a monument build in 1983 to celebrate the bicentennial of the Treaty of Georgievsk and ongoing friendship between Georgia and Soviet Russia.

**Gergeti Trinity Church** is a popular name for Holy Trinity Church near the village of Gergeti in Georgia. The church is situated on the right bank of the river Chkheri (the left tributary of the river Terek), at an elevation of 2170 meters (7120 feet), under Mount Kazbek.





## Day 4

Breakfast at the hotel and day tour to **Kakheti Wine** Region .

This region is located in the eastern part of Georgia and is one of the most beautiful regions. Kakheti is a place where wine-making culture was born and spread from. The best wines come from Kakheti. Through the ages up until today Georgians have made wine in Kvevri. In 2013 UNESCO registered the kvevri wine making method on the list of the Intangible Cultural Heritage of Humanity

Our tour will start with excursion to the **wine cellar** with a free wine tasting.

Family Georgian traditional wine cellar on the way to the city of Love Signagi is an ideal place for those who prefer homemade Georgian wine and chacha prepared according to all traditional standards and recipes of Georgia you will be greeted by a hospitable host who will surely show the superb ChachaGon and tell a real colloric Georgian toast.

Masster classes: **Baking Georgian Bread SHOTI**.

**Pirosmanashvili Museum** -world famous Georgian painter.

**Monastery of St. Nino** in Bodbe - Originally was built in the 9th Century. It is one of the major pilgrimage sites in Georgia. Monastery holds the tomb of ST. Nino, the Cappadocian maiden who converted Georgian people to Christianity as early as 337 AD. It has a breathtaking view of the Alazani valley and snowcapped Caucasus mountains.

**Sighnaghi – City of Love**. It is the prettiest town in Kaheti. Sighnagi orginally was developed in the 18th century by King Erekle II. The defensive walles and 28 towers were built by him against Lezgian invasion. The city has wonderful views over the Alazani valley to the Caucasus beyond.
